

ILLUSTRATIVE TIMELINE LOADING OR UNLOADING A TANKER

TOTAL DURATION: APPROXIMATELY 8 HOURS



IMPORTANT

- Every hour, an operator conducts a safety round and checks communication at the vessel.
- When handing over the radio, signal strength and battery are checked.
- Communication via radio takes place at pre-agreed moments.
- The radio gives a signal when the battery is low; replace it immediately and carry out a new check afterwards.
- A back-up communication line is always available in the form of an intercom on the jetty and/or an emergency number via telephone.
- The volume checks mentioned are examples and may vary depending on product and procedure. Depending on the situation, a check may take place at multiple moments during the process.
- At a shift change, a new communication check is carried out.
- All times shown are indicative and situation-dependent. The timeline is intended as an illustrative example and not as an established working method or procedure.
